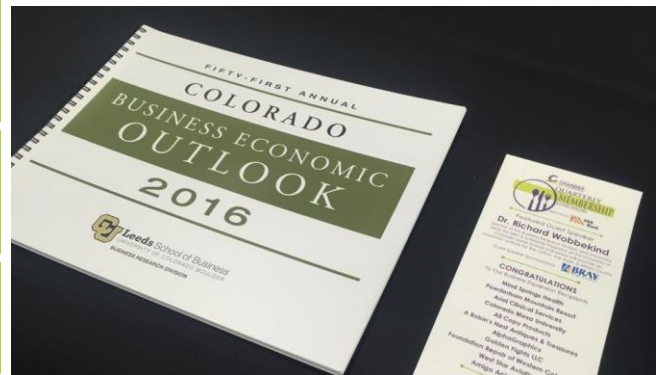

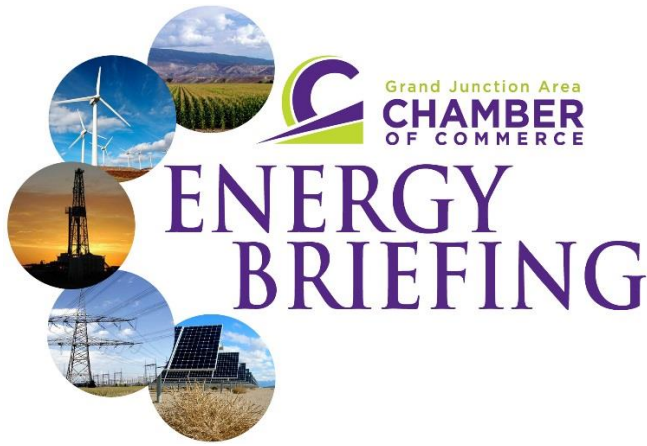

\$19.2 Rate Unchanged
Minimum Rates Take Effect December 1st
The value threshold will be increased to \$47,470 annually (\$393/week) an increase of slightly more than 100% from the current threshold of \$13,600 annually (\$45/week). The projected level was \$50,440 annually (\$970/week). There will be no changes to the dollar test.

Welcome to Grand Junction!

Second Quarter Accomplishments
The second quarter of the year from April through June is traditionally one of our most active periods in terms of serving our members and making progress on our annual business plan. Shown below are just a few of our accomplishments:
• Led the community effort to lobby the Economic Development week in coordination with our economic development partners, GEDP and BEC. A sales tax that can be used to attract new businesses can take advantage of the resources we offer to grow is now posted on the website.
• Defeated the local business closure by legally challenging the Grand Valley Drainage District's fee assessment on businesses which resulted in individual businesses being billed in excess of \$8,000. The matter is still in the courts. Our argument is that this is a defunct tax and subject to a vote under the Twenty-Sixth of Rights.
• Created the Foundation for a new funding mechanism to undertake Chamber business assistance programming known as the Todd Johnson Campaign.
• Hosted three business after hours events, three networking at Mount Morrison and attended 12 companies in assessing big data to identify and market to customers through a partnership with the Mesa County Library.

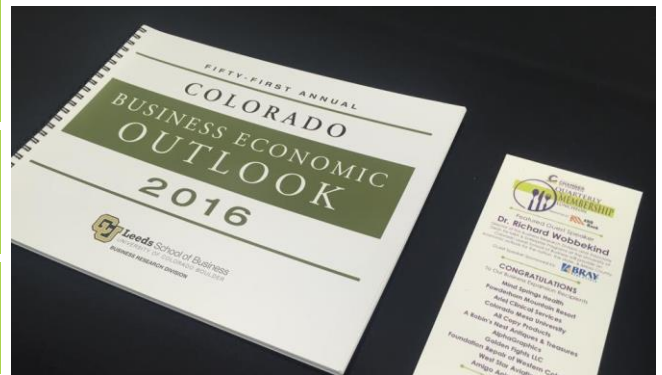

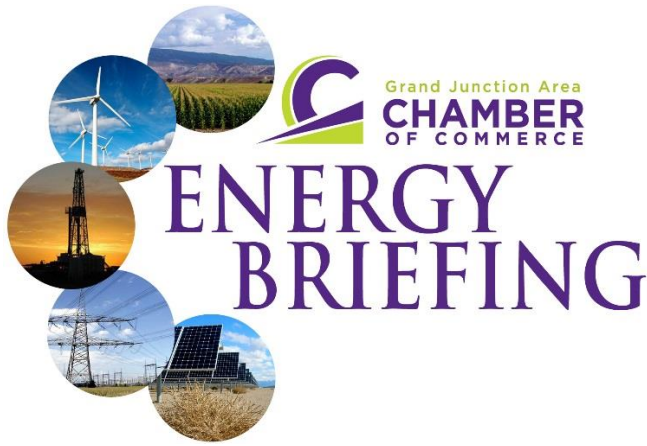

The second quarter of the year from April through June is traditionally one of our most active periods in terms of serving our members and making progress on our annual business plan. Shown below are just a few of our accomplishments:
• Led the community effort to lobby the Economic Development week in coordination with our economic development partners, GEDP and BEC. A sales tax that can be used to attract new businesses can take advantage of the resources we offer to grow is now posted on the website.
• Defeated the local business closure by legally challenging the Grand Valley Drainage District's fee assessment on businesses which resulted in individual businesses being billed in excess of \$8,000. The matter is still in the courts. Our argument is that this is a defunct tax and subject to a vote under the Twenty-Sixth of Rights.
• Created the Foundation for a new funding mechanism to undertake Chamber business assistance programming known as the Todd Johnson Campaign.
• Hosted three business after hours events, three networking at Mount Morrison and attended 12 companies in assessing big data to identify and market to customers through a partnership with the Mesa County Library.
